1. Introduction

Welcome to the Cookie Policy of treebytree B.V. ("we," "our," or "us"). This policy explains what cookies are, how we use them, and your choices regarding their usage. Please read this policy carefully.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on your computer or mobile device when you visit our website: www.treebytree.earth.

3. Why do we use Cookies?

By using cookies, we can see how our website is used and how we can optimize our services. Cookies are also helpful to make the website quick and safe. See the table below for the specific purposes of each cookie we use.

4. Types of Cookies We Use

We use the following types of cookies on our website:

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies:** These cookies are essential for the operation of our website and enable you to access and navigate the site securely.
- **Functional Cookies:** These cookies allow us to remember your choices (such as your language preferences) and provide enhanced, more personalized features.
- **Analytical/Performance Cookies:** These cookies help us analyze how visitors use our website, allowing us to improve its functionality.
- **Third-Party Cookies:** We may also use cookies from third-party service providers, such as Google Analytics, to track website usage and statistics.

For the use of Analytical/Performance Cookies & Third-Party Cookies, we ask for your consent. You may always withdraw your consent. You can do this via your browser. For details on why, by whom, and for how long your information is used through these cookies, please refer to the table below.

Google Analytics	._ga	This cookie is used to distinguish unique users by assigning a randomly generated number as a client identifier. It is included in each page request in a site and used to calculate visitor, session and campaign data for the sites analytics reports.	14 months
HubSpot	._hstc	The main cookie for tracking visitors. It contains the domain, hubspotutk, initial timestamp (first visit), last timestamp (last visit), current timestamp (this visit), and session number (increments for each subsequent session).	6 months
HubSpot	._hssc	This cookie keeps track of sessions. This is used to determine if HubSpot should increment the session number	30 minutes

		and timestamps in the <code>__hstc</code> cookie. It contains the domain, <code>viewCount</code> (increments each <code>pageView</code> in a session), and session start timestamp.	
HubSpot	<code>__cf_bm</code>	This cookie is used to distinguish between humans and bots. This is beneficial for the website, in order to make valid reports on the use of their website.	30 minutes
Microsoft Azure AD B2C Identity Server	<code>x-ms-cpim-csrf</code>	This cookie is used to prevent Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) attacks, ensuring that each client interaction with the server is unique and secure.	End of browser session

You can manage or delete cookies according to your preferences. For details, refer to the "help" section of your browser or device settings. Please note that if you disable cookies, some website features may not function correctly.

6. Changes to This Cookie Policy
